


Accessing the MSF Basic eCourse in Spanish

When a user opens up the course from the elearning.msf-usa.org site, the course will check if the student's browser is in Spanish. If the browser is in Spanish, then the Spanish version of the course will be delivered. If the student's browser is in a language other than Spanish, then the student will have to change the setting themselves.

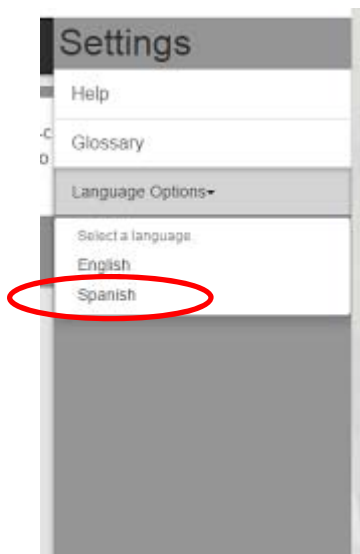
To access the Basic eCourse in Spanish, log into your account and enter the eCourse. Once in, click on the gear button on the bottom right of the screen:



This will open up a Settings menu that gives you “Language Options”:
